The Student Account defrays costs such as: school books, educational and recreational outings, rides to the train station, snacks and laundry. This amount is the initial deposit for the student account; subsequently, it is replenished as depleted. A minimum of \$100.00 is the necessary balance in each student's account. Any unused portion of the Student Account is refundable. The application fee, tuition deposit and tuition are nonrefundable.

Room, board, and tuition are payable by the Semester, Year or Monthly thru FACTS.

The total amount of tuition for which these families are responsible will be divided into ten (10) payments. If, during the school year, this student does not meet the academic and/or conduct guidelines of that scholarship, the family will be notified and tuition expense will be added to their FACTS account.
