***The Weekend Fee** covers the cost of weekend room and board. Student is not charged for weekends he stays off campus. Any unused portion of the Weekend Fee is refundable at the end of the school year.

****The Student Account** pays for shuttle services to the airport and train station, off campus meals during the week when attending school sporting events, snack foods and any supplies or incidentals deemed necessary per the student's discretion. This account is managed by the School Treasurer. Any unused portion of the Student Account is returned to the student at the end of the school year.
